She became, however, one of the most inspirational people of the 20th century. Facing the challenges of a world she didn't understand and a world that could not understand her, she was able to rise above her circumstances and bring order to her life. In so doing she and her teacher, Anne Sullivan, brought innovation to the education of the deaf and blind

I first encountered the story of Helen Keller when I was in Year 6 at school. I sat enthralled as my teacher, Mr Kallas, read to the class about this amazing woman. From that day forward I had a new hero. One who taught me that I too can overcome the challenges that life has, and will continue, to throw my way.

- Revise your work consolidate your learning

We have undertaken a revision of our teaching and assessment materials for selected students to ensure the SKILLS and CONCEPTS necessary for success in the Selective High School Placement Test and OC Test are well-addressed. Immediate Changes:

- All Year 6 students will receive information bulletins covering the changes to the Writing, Reading, Mathematical Reasoning and Thinking Skills papers. Besides explanations of the new styles of questions, students are also provided with sample questions and answers.
- These bulletins will be issued in Weeks One to Three of
- New test questions in the **Year 6 Exam Preparation Program** that directly reflect changes in the Thinking Skills paper.
- New writing tasks commencing Week 2 in the **Year 6 Exam Preparation Program** that directly reflect changes in the Writing paper.
- New 'Thinking Skills' pages in the **Fastrain & High Achiever** weekly workbooks for Years 5 & 6. This will commence in Term One Week One and will continue through to Term Four Week Ten.
- New writing tasks in the **Writing for Exam Success Program for Year 6.** The new tasks reflect the change in the focus for the 2021 Selective High School Placement Test Writing paper. Other fine tuning in our teaching materials

Ongoing Changes:

- Revised: Writing tasks, English, Mathematical Reasoning, and Thinking Skills activities for Years 3 to 6 to ensure skills development is in line with requirements for new OC Test and Selective High School Placement Test.
- Revised Holiday Programs for Years 3 to 6 to ensure content & skills development is in line with real and anticipated changes to 2021 OC Test and Selective High School Placement


